New to the show this fall is **Matt Ballagh** on lead vocals and bass, an up-and-coming young star who has performed for **Drayton Entertainment** in *Fiddler on the Loose, Sorry I'm Canadian*. Matt also designed sound this season for Drayton's *Jesus Christ Superstar & Shrek: The Musical, and his family band, The Ballagh Bunch, appeared on Canada's Family Fued*. When these talented fellas vocalize, the audience is treated to world-class harmonies and solos.

Way and her band have brought Canada many great concerts, including last years sold-out **Early Morning Rain (The Legend of Gordon Lightfoot)**. Way's *Canada 150* concert toured to 44 cities across the country, and her concerts, *Sweet Dreams* (**Patsy Cline**), and *Rhinestone Cowgirl* (**Dolly Parton**), and Across the Pond: The British Invasion are critically acclaimed and well-loved by audiences everywhere. And now, Way celebrates the legendary stars of the Grand Ole Opry by raising the roof with the hottest country songs in history.
